# FALL COVID-19 ECONOMIC IMPACT SURVEY

CHBA BC conducted its second COVID-19 Economic Impact (Fall) Survey of its members. Distributed through our eight local associations, the purpose of this survey is to receive insight on how the pandemic has economically affected business operations of our members. A total of 198 valid responses were received.



Over **30%** expect an increase in business between Nov. to March 2021

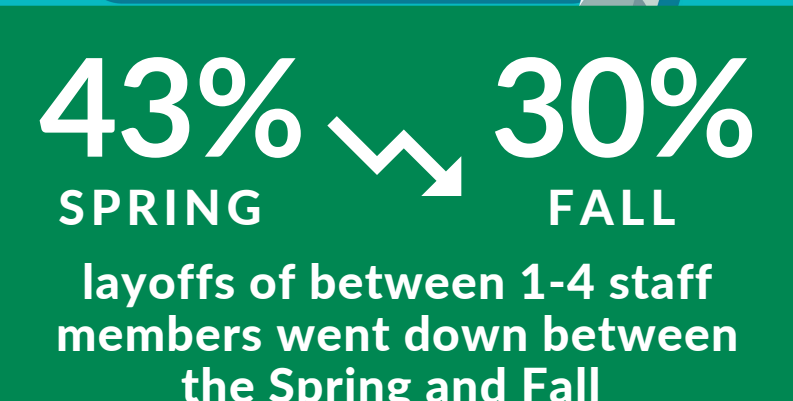


**70%** saw an increase in the time it takes for their permits to be approved since June 2020
